

# New PCR test requirement for travellers on Qatar Airways from Tanzania

Dear Trade Partner,

Effective 2 March 2021, customers travelling on Qatar Airways flights from ZNZ, DAR and JRO will require to present a negative PCR test certificate from an authorised laboratory prior to departure.

The PCR test certificate must be issued within 96 hours prior to departure, or within a shorter time period where mandated by a local authority.

In addition to the original PCR test certificate, a [signed consent form](#) must also be provided at the airport. Customers without these documents will not be permitted to travel. Children under 12 are exempt when travelling with their family.
